We have reviewed the test data for your block product including the following:


Central Testing Laboratory	Compressive strength
Certified Testing Laboratories	Flexural strength
Architectural Testing	Flexural bond strength
National Association of Home Builders	Shear strength

We have also performed calculations relating these strength and stiffness parameters with the requirements of the International Building Code 2009 (IBC) and the International Residential Code (IRC) and find that your 8" thick block product is quite useful for single and multi-story buildings, both light commercial and residential.

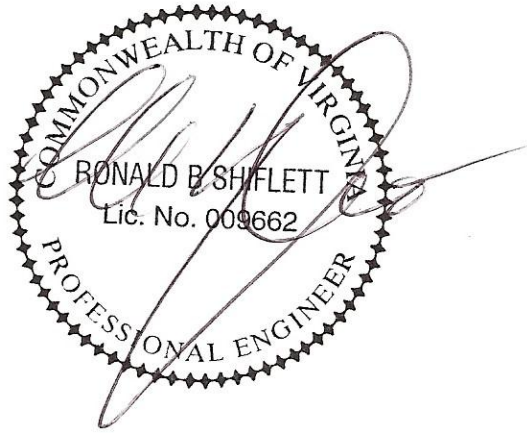
In addition, the blocks possess excellent dimensional uniformity and uniformity of surface texture. These features greatly enhance the usefulness of the product. Their dimensional uniformity makes it possible for non-masons to install them in many cases. The uniformity of surface textures enhances the use of minimal finishes or no finish at all.
