Summary: Titan Tiles seeks to manufacture a water resistant, interlocking roof tile for homes and businesses.

Market Opportunity / Validation:

- Within the U. S. market alone; there are approximately 2,480 manufacturers and distributors of roofing tiles. In each of the last five years, annual revenues have exceeded \$15.4 billion. Annual payrolls in each of the last five years have exceeded \$1.4 billion. There are approximately 35,000 people employed by the industry.
- The roofing industry is expected to increase substantially over the next five years as new housing starts continue to improve. Additionally, the number of households that have roofs reaching the age of 25 is starting to increase. As such, many homeowners may chose to use the long lasting Titan Roof Tiles when they need to replace their roofs. The estimated year on year growth rate for the industry is expected to be 3% to 4% per year during the next five years.

Business Problem:

 Roof tiles are very expensive; they crack when walked on (during roof repairs or when repairing other cracked tiles), blow off in storms and are very hard to match when repairs are made. The manufacturing process requires firing the tile at high temperatures for long periods of time. Firing is costly and not a green process.

The Titan Solution:

• Titan roof tiles are stronger than most conventional tiles and will last much longer than many other tiles on the market today. They add insulation value to the roof while protecting the roof from fires and storms. Our manufacturing process is very green because our tiles are cured, not fired. The strength of the tiles should prevent them from cracking or breaking when walked on. Management feels Titan tiles could be produced in almost any shape for only 30 or 40 cents each. They can even be made to look like clay barrel tiles that often sell for \$5 to \$12 a piece.
